

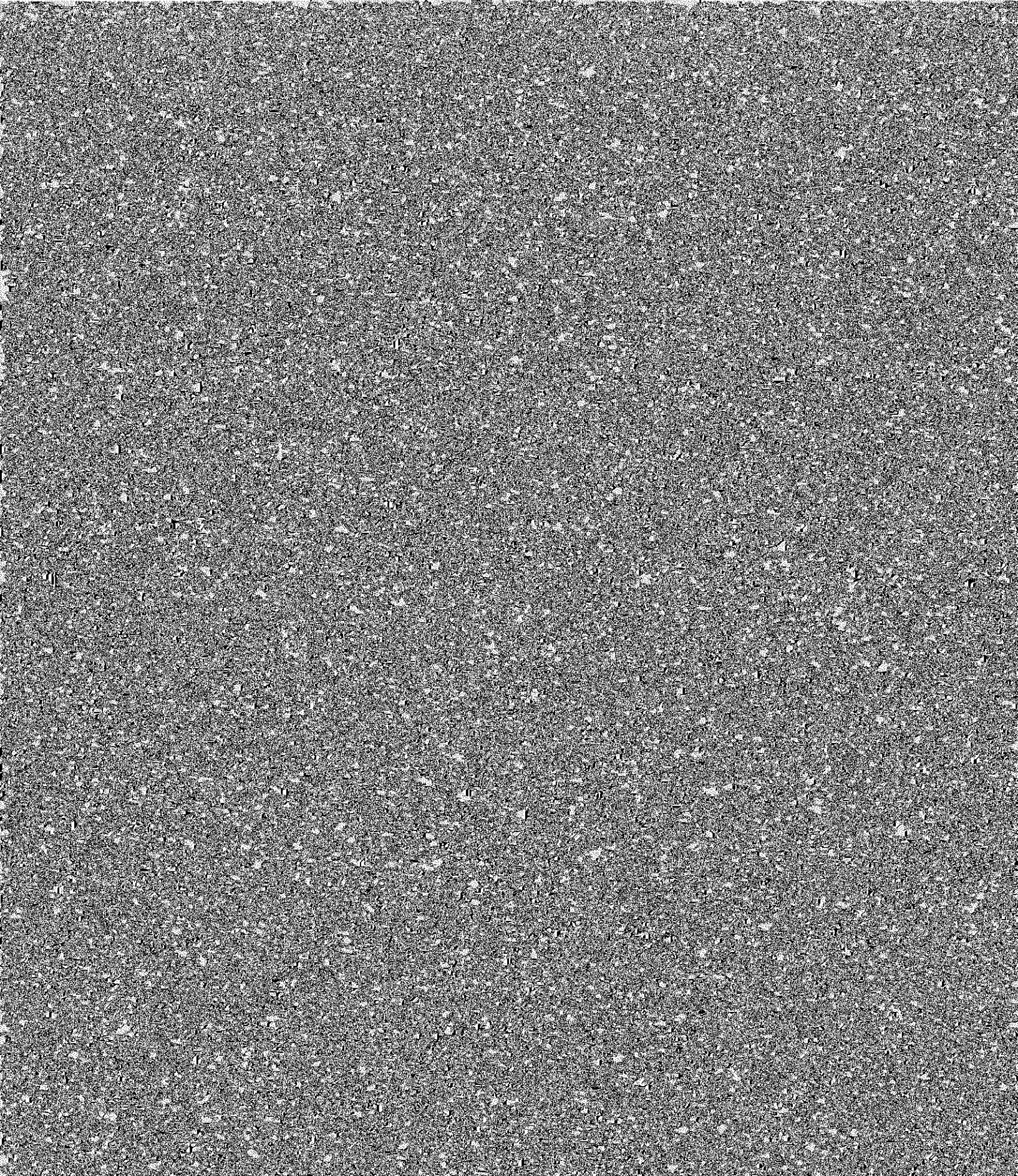

Employer Types by Gender



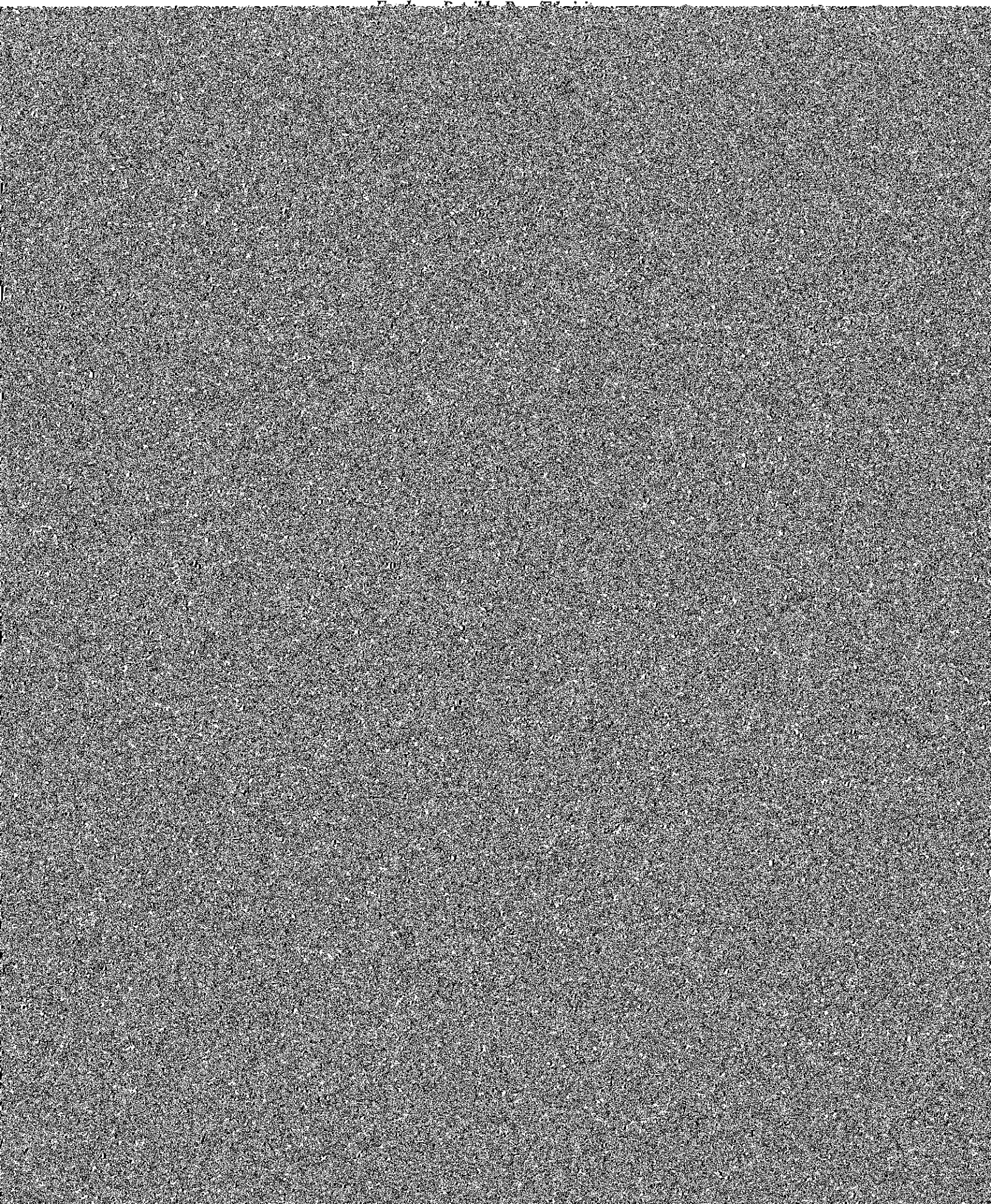
Employer Types by Age at Graduation

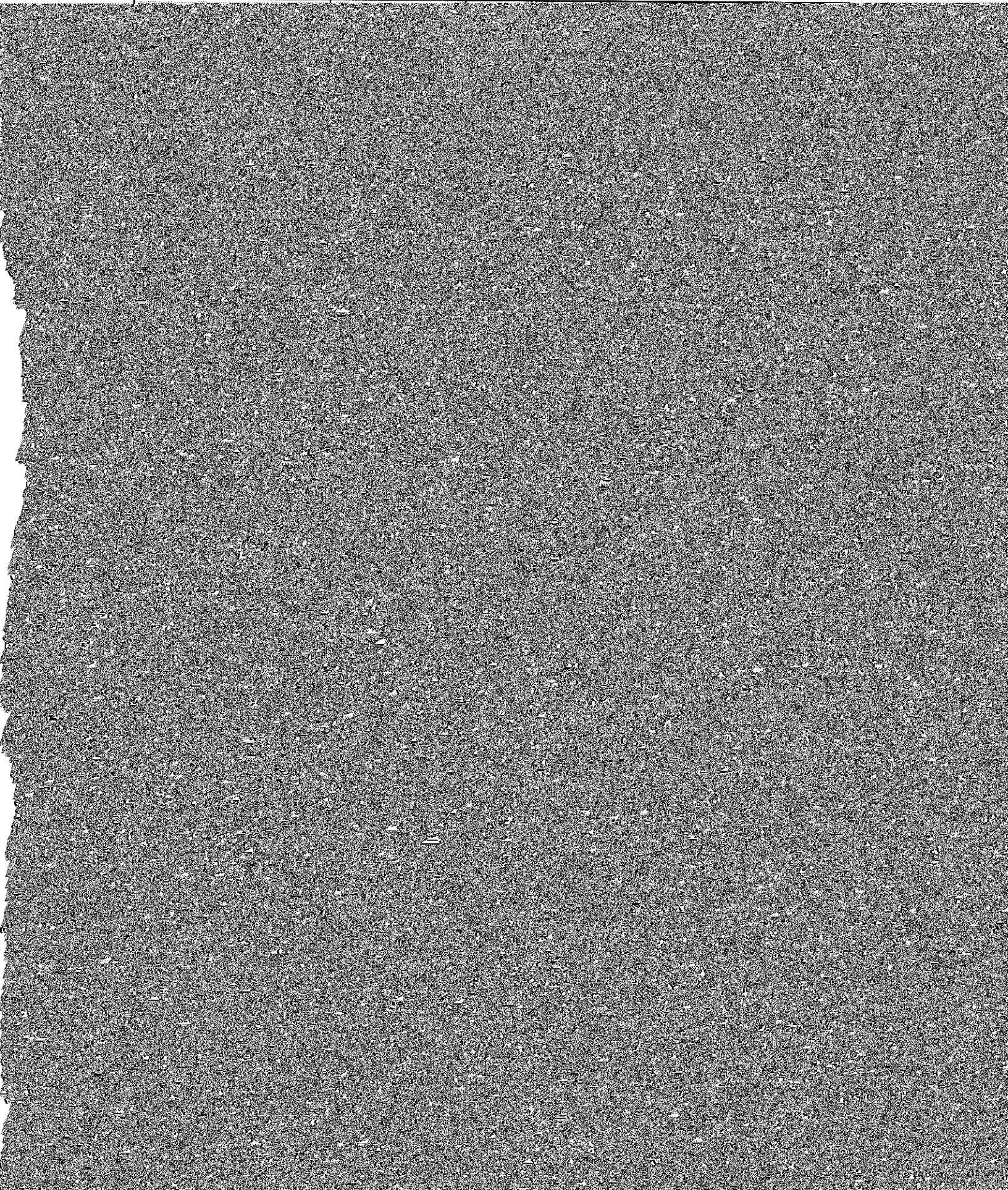
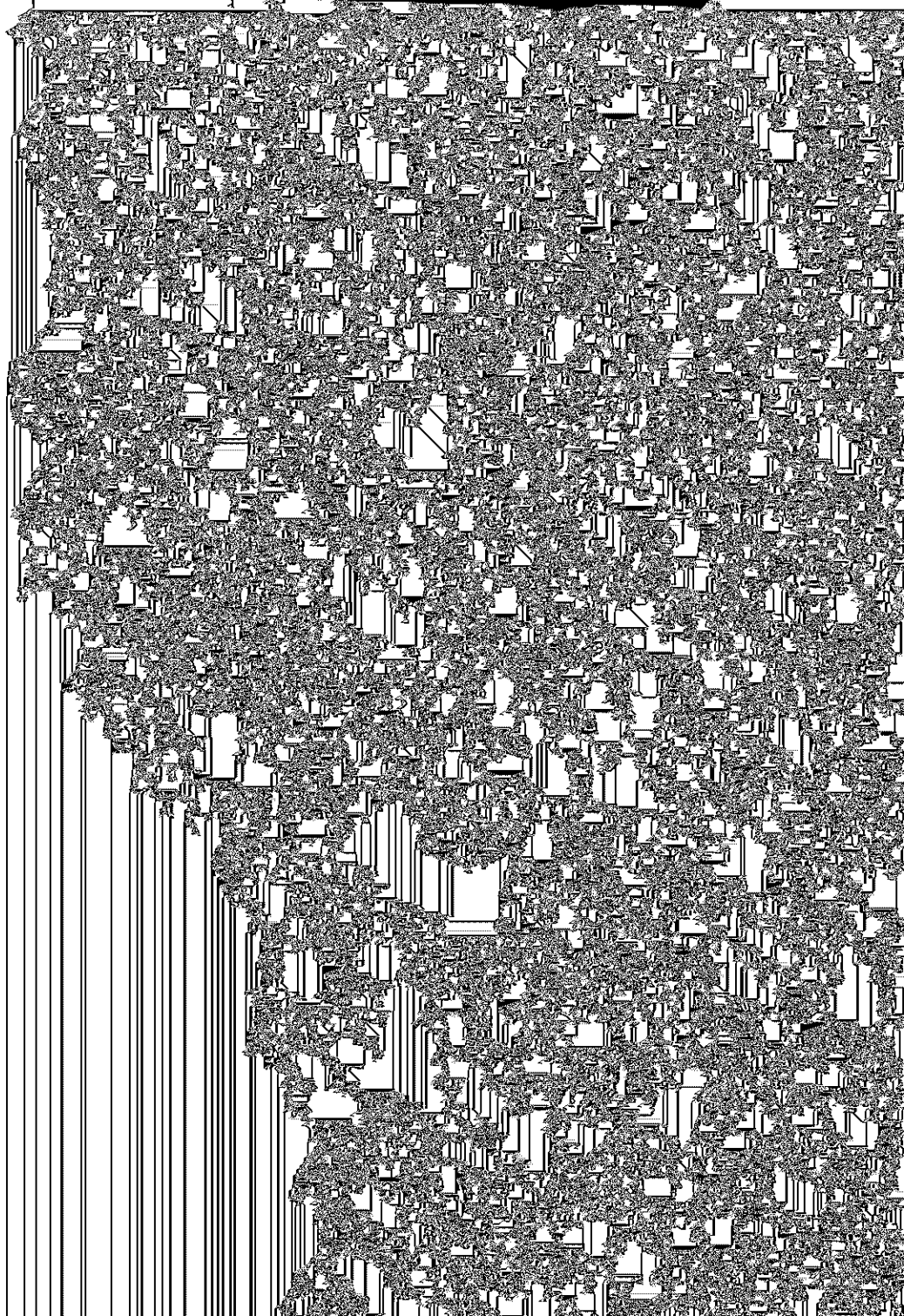
